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#### 4. STAGES

##### Stage 1: Paper Assessment

The documents that you have submitted are assessed against the syllabus and other requirements

- Outcome 1: Your documents do not meet the requirements and you will be advised on the training that you need to do; or
- Outcome 2: : Your documents meet the requirements and you undergo the next stage

##### Stage 2: Professional Interview

A half-hour professional interview is arranged with you either face-to-face or by telephone

- Outcome 3: Your interview is not successful and you need to take additional training; or
- Outcome 4: Your interview is successful and you need to do a project or technical interview

##### Stage 3: Project or Technical Interview

A project or technical interview (three hours) is arranged with you either face-to-face or by telephone or you submit a project to the Assessment Committee

- Outcome 5: Your interview or project is not successful and you need to take additional training; or
- Outcome 6: Your interview or project is successful and you are eligible to take the examinations without any further training

##### Stage 4: Undertake examinations

You enrol for the CSWI/IWI S examinations
